The workshop also aims to provide basic knowledge and skills to participants in customizing Koha OPAC for creating, designing, conceptualizing and managing as website as well.

About Koha:

Koha is a Open-Source (OSS) Web-based Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) that includes modules for Circulation, Cataloguing, Acquisitions, Serials, Patron (Member) management, Library Branch relationships, and many more features. Koha is built using international library standards and protocols that ensure interoperability between Koha and other systems. It supports technologies and standards like MARC, Z39.50, RFID, web 2.0, etc. The user interface is configurable and adaptable and has been translated into many languages. Koha has most of the features that would be expected in an ILS, including:

- Simple, clear interface for librarians and members (patrons)
- Circulation and borrower management
- Full acquisitions system including budgets and pricing information
- Simple acquisitions system for the smaller library
- Ability to handle multiple independent branches of libraries
- Serials system for magazines, Journals or newspapers Reporting
- Union catalog facility
- Customizable search
- Web 2.0 facilities like tagging, comment, Social sharing and RSS feeds
- Reading lists for members
